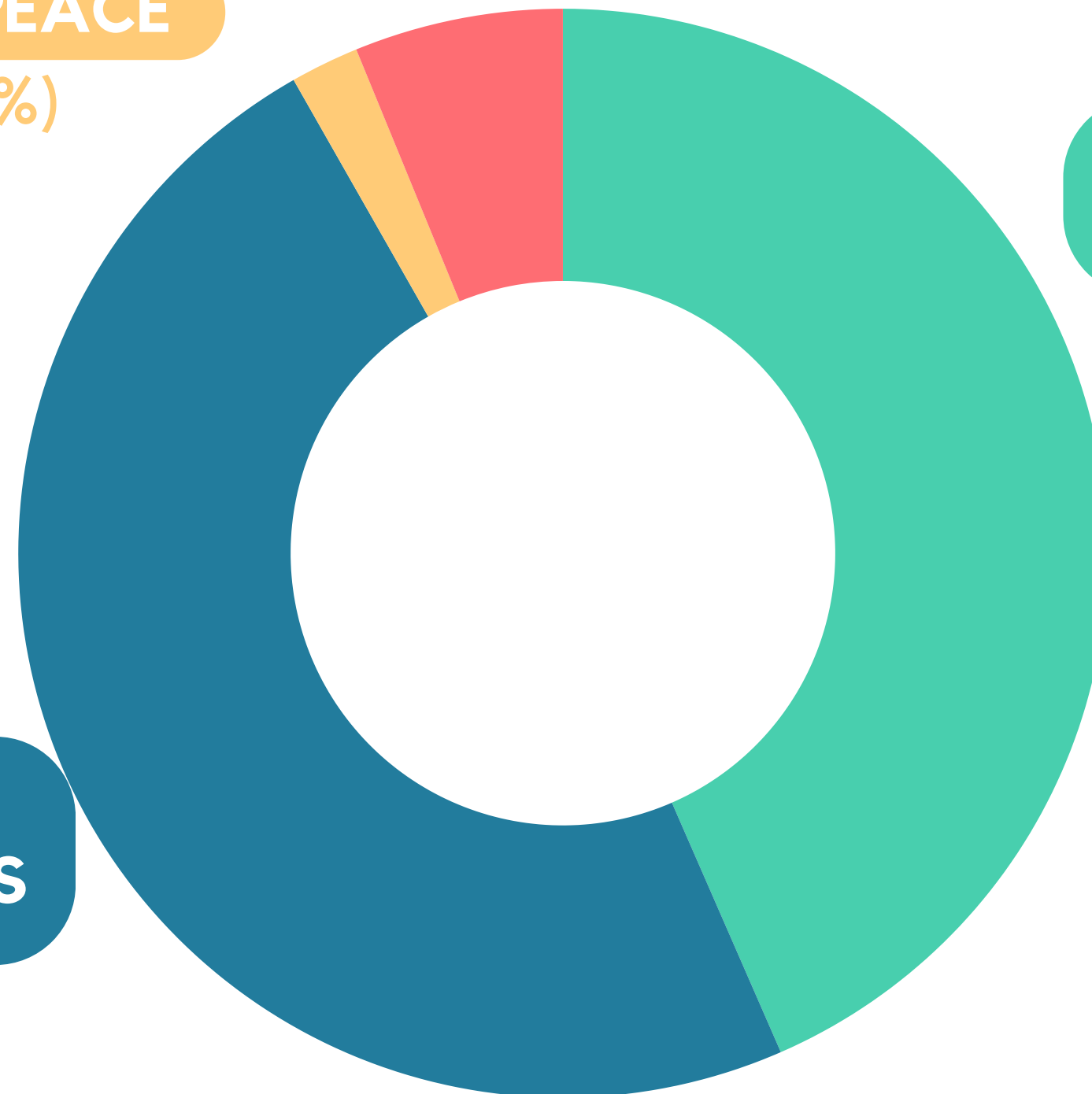

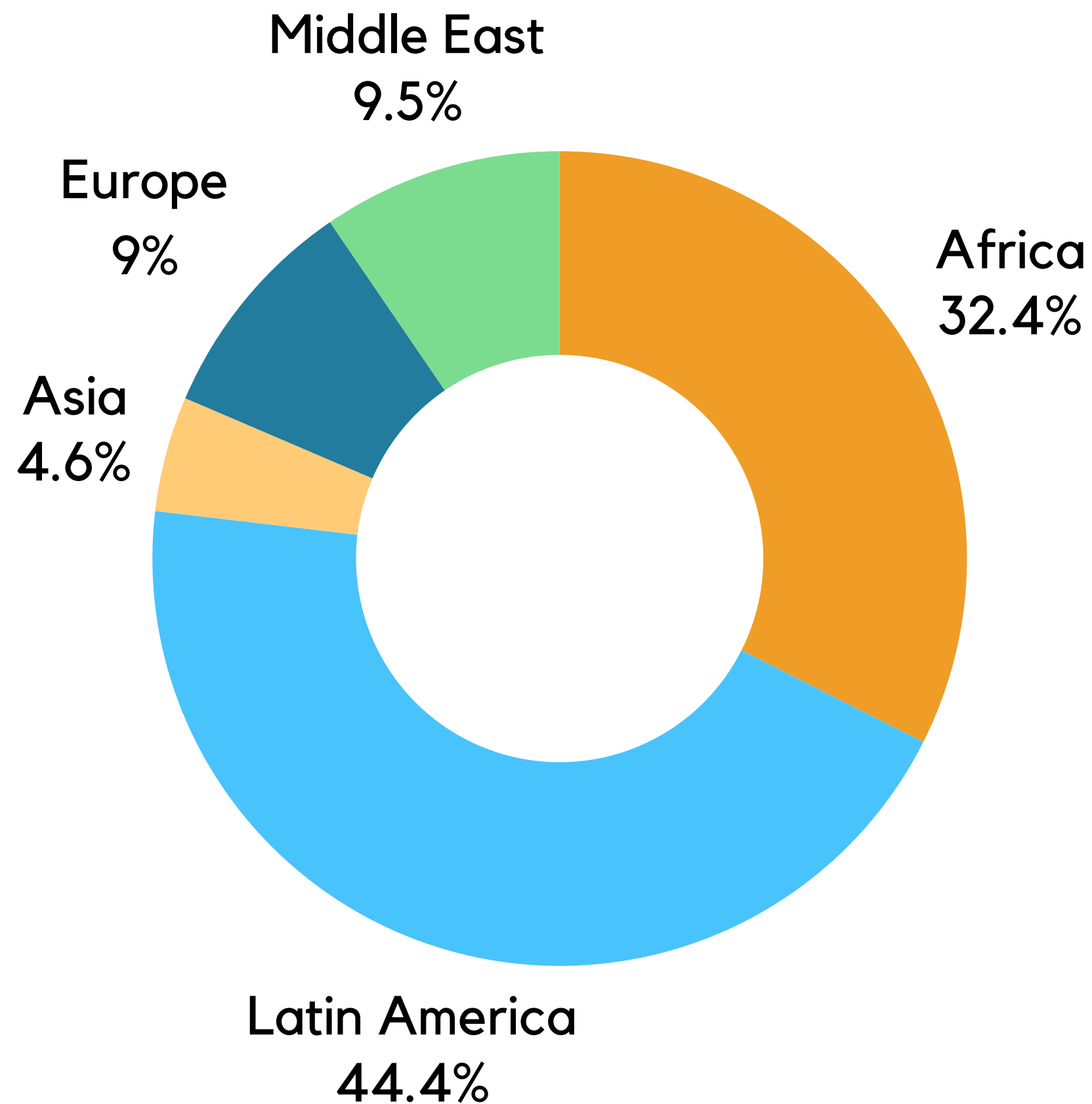

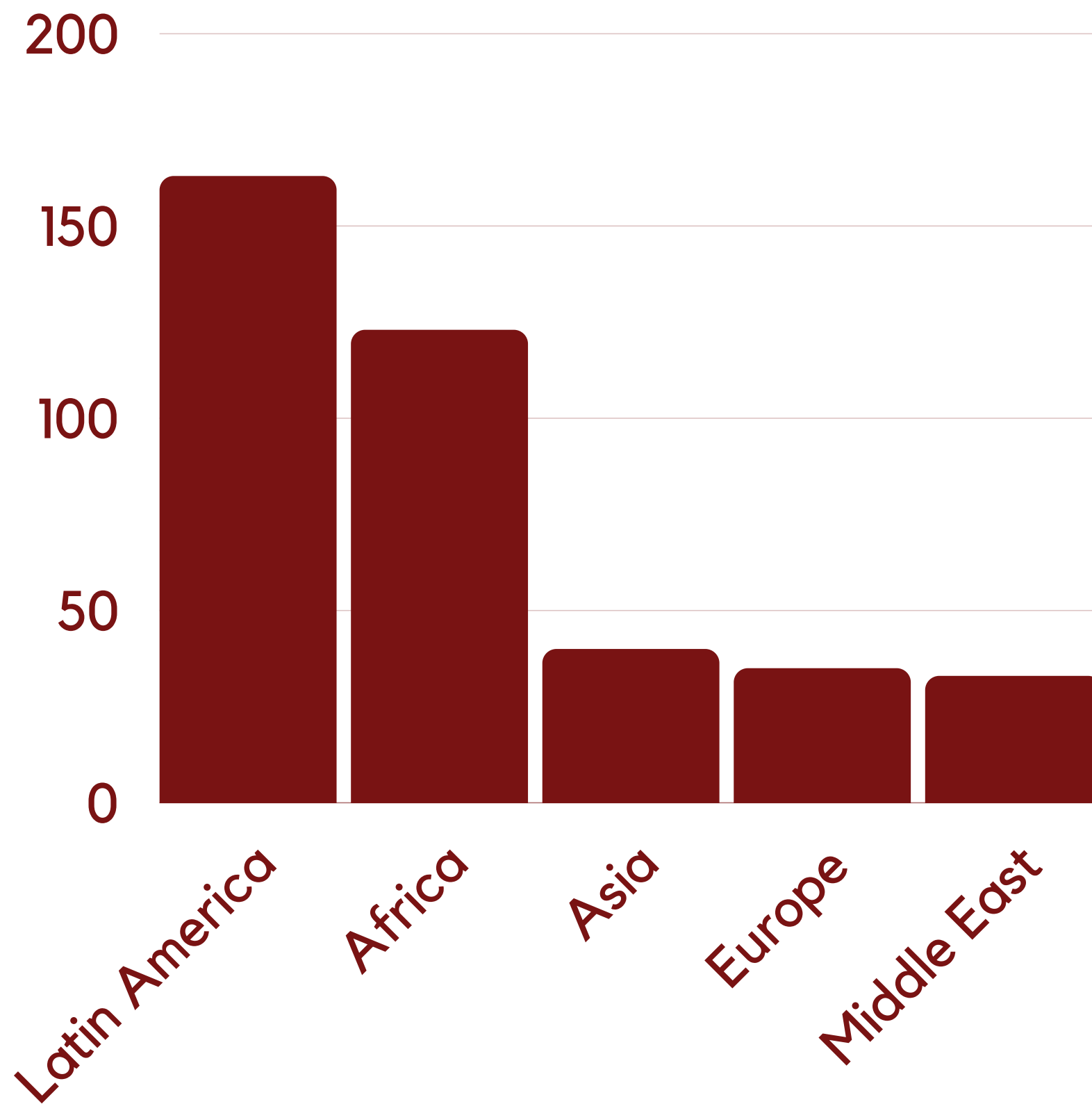


# PARTICIPANTS REACHED BY GEOGRAPHICAL AREA

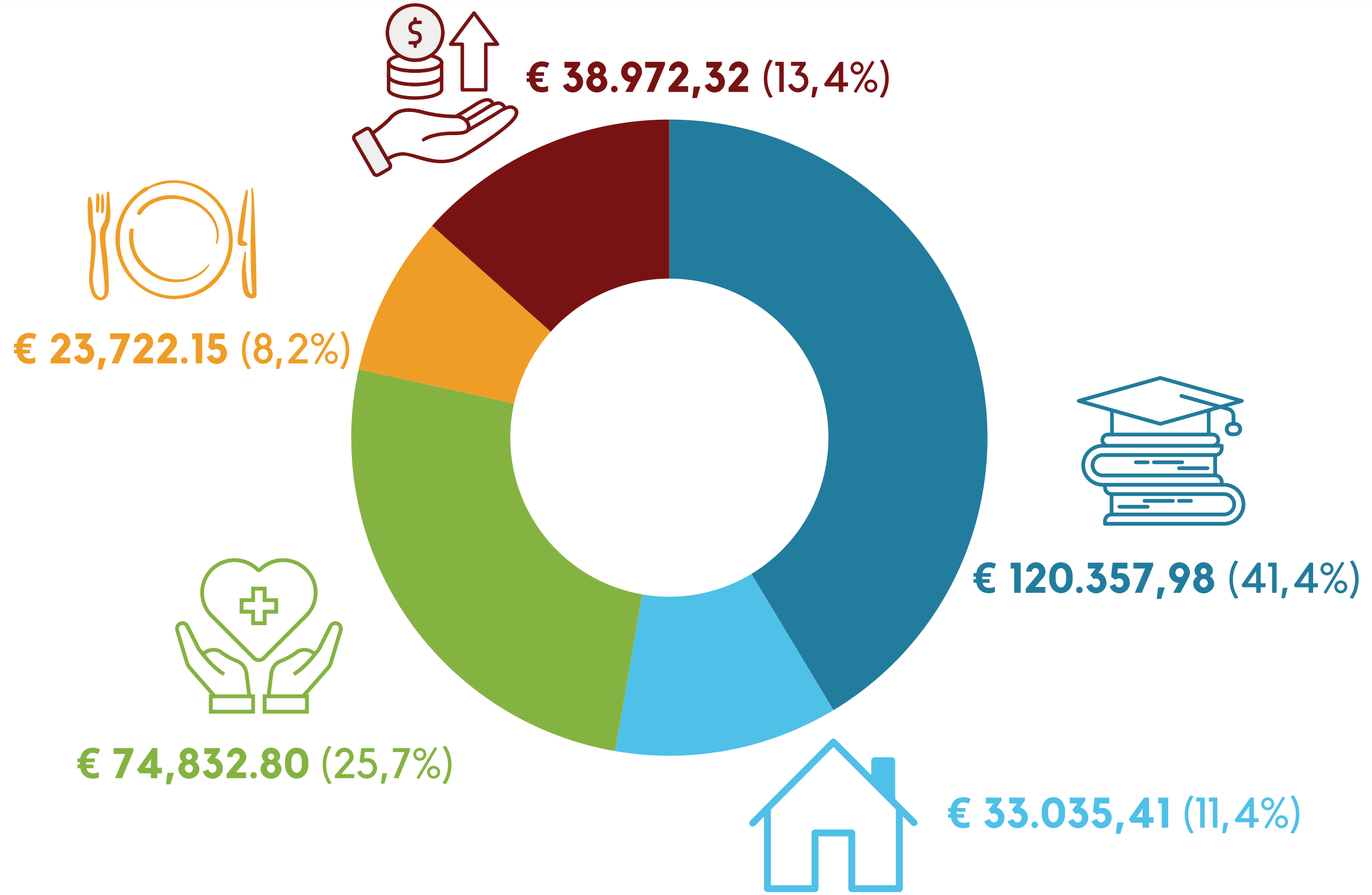
